Fall 2009: An «Opportunity and concept definition study» was completed about a project of a future home dedicated to aerospace at the École Nationale d'Aérotechnique and the Aerospace Technology Centre.

August 2018: Foundation of the QAM in Saint-Hubert with the objective of becoming a showcase for the aerospace industry.

The year 2027 will mark the 100th anniversary of the creation of the Saint-Hubert airport, a historic site for aviation in Canada. Right now, although Quebec is one of the world's leading aerospace hubs, there is no place where the public can discover the industry, its companies and achievements on a permanent basis. The QAM's project to establish a museum at Saint-Hubert airport should address this void.

QAM Main Objectives:

- To become the showcase for Quebec and Canada's Aerospace Industry;
- Clearly assert the industry's identity to the general public;
- Attract young people towards careers in science, technology and aerospace, while supporting academic perseverance;
- Offer a unique multifunctional venue in Quebec for professional development, networking and event organization;
- Organize and participate in social activities;
- Highlight the heritage of the aerospace industry in Quebec and Canada, as well as its present and future, that will raise the profile of the industry, its companies and institutions, and its achievements, both in Quebec and around the world.
- Create an ecosystem with organizations pursuing a similar goal in Quebec.
